## Code of Conduct



### Aim

To provide a safe environment in our School/Centre where everyone is respected.

### Objectives

To encourage adults and children to listen to each other, share experiences and to be kind, considerate and understanding.

To recognise the importance of praising positive behaviour in children.

To challenge behaviour in a positive way.

In Everton Nursery School and Family Centre we:

- Respect all people regardless of their age, gender, race, ethnicity, sexuality and/or disability.
- Believe that children of all ages should respect each other and should be respected by adults, therefore swearing and the use of disrespectful terms should not be used for children, or other adults.
- Believe that verbal and/or physical aggression will not be tolerated by parents or staff of any organisation.

Parents/carers/visitors may have different views on shouting and smacking children. At Everton Nursery School and Family Centre we would like everyone to respect children and when annoyed not respond to them by smacking or shouting.

Our Code of Conduct also acknowledges that the School/Centre is a non alcohol, non drugs and non smoking building.

Do not use your mobile telephone within the Nursery side of the building. You are welcome to use your mobile in the Foyer and the outdoor areas.

Social Networks are a great way of staying in touch with people, please do not use Social Networks to discuss confidential information or to upset/harass others.

If you have seen or heard anything in the School/Centre or via Social Networking which has made you feel uncomfortable, you can do one of the following:

- Share the incident with a member of staff in confidence.
- Put the incident in writing and hand it to reception, place in the suggestion box or pass to a senior member of staff.

Anyone consuming alcohol, drugs or smoking on the premises or within the perimeter fence around the site will be asked to leave the premises. This includes, staff, parents/carers and visitors to the School/Centre/Site at any time.
